#1: Opening of formal email Strengths: Your formal salutation establishes an appropriate tone. You clearly state your purpose in the opening paragraph. It also fails to include the requested figurative language and sensory descriptions. Exemplar: *Imagine your company logo displayed prominently on our new playground equipment, like a beacon drawing hundreds of local families to the space where they'll associate your business with joyful memories. Your emails demonstrate a solid understanding of different writing styles needed for formal versus informal communication. However, both emails would benefit significantly from more vivid sensory details that bring the playground's current condition and potential transformation to life. The formal email needs stronger emotional appeals and specific statistics about safety concerns or community impact. The informal email requires clearer benefits for the business sponsor and more engaging figurative language.

Additionally, your emails lack the specific elements requested in the prompt. Neither email fully incorporates the required two examples of figurative language, emotionally evocative language, or vivid physical descriptions engaging three senses. These elements would make your persuasive writing more powerful and align with the assignment requirements.

• To strengthen both emails, focus on including specific sensory details about the playground's current state (what does it look like, sound like, feel like now?) and contrast this with vibrant descriptions of what it could become. Add metaphors or similes to help readers visualise the transformation. For the formal email, include specific safety concerns and community demographics to build a stronger case. For the informal email, clearly outline the business benefits of sponsorship, perhaps mentioning visibility, community goodwill, and potential customer engagement.
