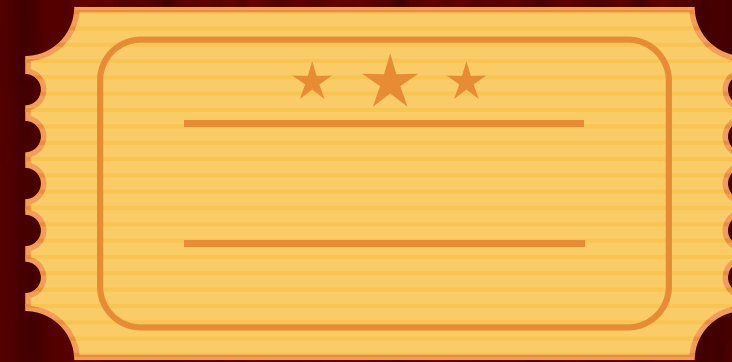
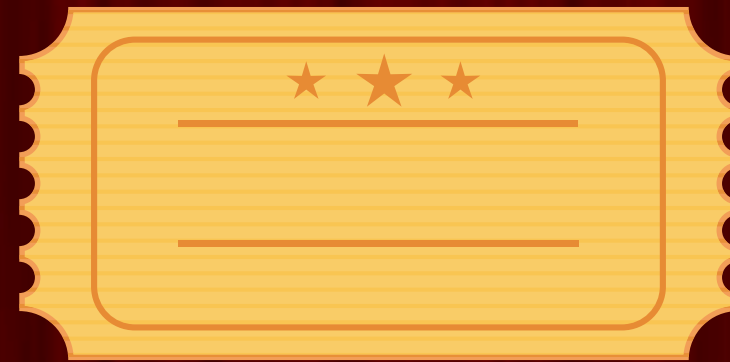
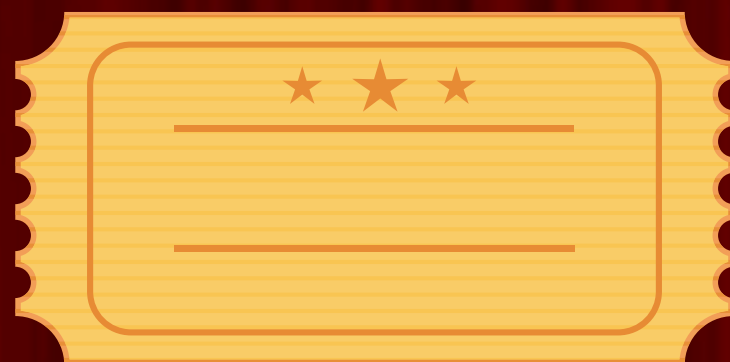
Writing Prompt
