#1 Opening paragraph introducing the mysterious door

Strengths: Your opening immediately creates intrigue with the hidden door in the tree trunk, and you establish the conflict well by mentioning both the promise of abundance and the warnings about danger. Weakness: Unclear character motivation → You mention Mia found the map "in a chest under her bed" without explaining how it got there or why she decided to follow it, leaving readers confused about her initial motivation. Exemplar: Deep in the forest, Mia stood before an ancient wooden door hidden within an old tree's trunk, clutching the mysterious map she had discovered in her grandmother's chest just that morning.

#2 Mia's internal conflict and decision to enter

Strengths: You effectively show Mia's hesitation and internal struggle, making her feel like a real person facing a difficult choice. Weakness: Abrupt transition between thoughts → The sentence "But she had come so far. Giving up now wasn't an option" feels disconnected from her previous uncertainty and doesn't show how she resolved her fear. Exemplar: After staring at the door for several minutes, Mia realised that her curiosity was stronger than her fear—she had to know what lay beyond.

#3 The encounter with the shadow creature

Strengths: You build good tension with the creature's appearance and Mia's frozen response, creating a genuine sense of danger. Weakness: Incomplete scene resolution → The creature simply doesn't move as Mia walks through it, but you don't explain why it allowed her to pass or what made her brave enough to try. Exemplar: As Mia approached, the creature seemed to study her courage, then slowly stepped aside as if recognising her determination.

■ Your piece shows good imagination and creates an interesting fantasy world that draws readers in. However, you could strengthen the story by adding more details about why things happen and how your character makes important decisions. The plot moves quite quickly, which is exciting, but slowing down to explain Mia's thoughts and feelings would help readers understand her better. Additionally, some of your sentences could flow together more smoothly by using connecting words between ideas.

Actionable task: Focus on the paragraph where Mia decides to enter the door and expand it to show her thought process more clearly. Also, work on the ending section to explain how Mia overcame the shadow creature.
