The sentence structure needs revision to maintain the strong foundation you've established in your introduction.

Repetitive language  $\rightarrow$  You've used "world" three times in close succession, which creates redundancy. This repetition weakens your otherwise strong environmental argument and makes your writing sound less sophisticated.

Exemplar: Furthermore, scientific advancements have the power to create groundbreaking technologies that contribute heavily towards a more renewable future. While we all cherish our planet, it currently faces overwhelming challenges from pollution and numerous environmental crises threatening its stability.

Strengths: You've maintained good paragraph structure with the transition word "Moreover" and effectively established a direct comparison between art and medicine. Your specific example of the cannula adds credibility to your argument.

Unclear comparison  $\rightarrow$  The phrasing "unmatchable towards" doesn't clearly express the comparison you're trying to make between artistic expression and medical advancements. This creates confusion about your central argument and weakens the impact of your important point.

Exemplar: Moreover, artistic expression, while valuable, cannot match the countless benefits that advancements bring to the medicinal field. Simply put, while artworks may provide emotional comfort, they cannot directly relieve disease or serious pain, whereas medical inventions like the cannula can remedy conditions previously thought incurable.

To improve the substance of your writing, consider developing a more balanced argument by acknowledging specific values of artistic expression before explaining why science still takes precedence. For instance, in paragraph two, you could briefly mention how art provides emotional healing before explaining why medical interventions are ultimately more crucial. Additionally, your final paragraph would benefit from a stronger conclusion that reinforces your main points instead of introducing new ideas about economic growth. Try to create clearer links between your paragraphs so each one builds logically on the previous point. Also, your second paragraph about the asthmatic child creates a powerful image, but you could strengthen it by connecting it more clearly to your overall argument about science versus art.
