Strengths: Your description of the diamond bamboo stick creates a vivid image with specific details like "millions of tiny bumps" that help readers visualise this magical object.

Punctuation confusion \rightarrow Your opening sentence contains several punctuation errors that make it difficult to follow the panda's actions. The commas are placed incorrectly, breaking the flow of reading. For example, "hi friends" should be "his friends" and the comma after it interrupts the sentence structure

Strengths: Your description of the temple creates an eerie atmosphere with the mossy stone and grabbing vines, which adds excitement to the panda's adventure.

Run-on sentences \rightarrow Your sentences contain too many ideas joined together with commas and conjunctions. This makes it hard for readers to follow the sequence of events clearly. Also, "where" is used incorrectly when it should be "were."

As the panda's spinning slowed, he rose into the sky and zoomed across the world into another universe. He landed in a mossy stone temple where vines stretched out from every surface, looking as though they might reach out and grab him.

#3 "The panda was only 10 years old and didn't know what it ment, but as the bamboo stick teleported the panda back into his realm again, the puzzled face of his turned into a smile, as he suddenly realised what the staff ment!"

Strengths: You've created a satisfying conclusion where the character has a moment of realisation, giving your story a clear ending.

Spelling and word choice issues → There are spelling errors ("ment" instead of "meant") and awkward phrasing like "the puzzled face of his." The repetition of "the panda" makes the writing feel choppy.

The young ten-year-old panda didn't understand the message at first. However, as the bamboo stick teleported him back to his own realm, his puzzled expression transformed into a smile when he suddenly understood what the staff had meant.

■ Your adventure story has a creative concept with magical elements that young readers would enjoy. The diamond bamboo stick, teleportation, and mysterious temple create an exciting world. To improve your writing, focus on organising your ideas more clearly. Start each paragraph with a topic sentence that introduces what will happen next. Also, try reading your story aloud to catch awkward sentences and repeated words. You could add more details about how the panda feels during his adventure to help readers connect with him. Additionally, make sure each event follows logically from the previous one. Spend more time developing the message about not judging a book by its cover—perhaps show why this lesson is important to the panda. You might consider expanding the ending to show how the panda applies this new knowledge in his life.
