

## Section 1:

**#1** - Opening paragraph: "The first crash of thunder silenced the crowd. Everyone was in a state of taciturnity. People froze like a musician making a mistake in front of thousands of audience."

**Strengths:** Your opening creates immediate tension and uses sophisticated vocabulary like "taciturnity" to show advanced word knowledge. The musician comparison helps readers picture the frozen moment.

**Weakness:** Unclear sentence connections → Your sentences don't flow smoothly together, making it hard to follow your ideas. The phrase "while they spend their time processing the shock" appears suddenly without connecting properly to the previous sentence, and "thousands of audience" needs the word "members" to be grammatically correct.

**Exemplar:** *Whilst the crowd processed their shock, the air filled with astonishment.*

**#2** - Middle paragraph: "The black as cat clouds ensnared the stadium and surrounded above. The thunder crashed like cymbals being hit against each other and the air moved like a rapid bow of a violin."

**Strengths:** Your use of musical imagery (cymbals, violin bow) creates a strong theme that connects different parts of your writing. The word "ensnared" shows good vocabulary choice.

**Weakness:** Confusing comparisons → Your simile "black as cat clouds" doesn't make clear sense because cats can be many colours, and "surrounded above" is unclear. These unclear descriptions make it difficult for readers to picture what's happening in your story.

**Exemplar:** *The pitch-black clouds ensnared the stadium, surrounding it from above.*

**#3** - Final paragraph: "All hope of peaceful time was broken but this abruption would once result into a reward that could change the fate of the whole country."

**Strengths:** Your writing shows understanding of cause and effect, connecting the storm to positive outcomes. You demonstrate good story structure by building towards a resolution.

**Weakness:** Awkward word choices → Words like "abruption" and phrases like "would once result into" don't follow standard English patterns. Additionally, "peaceful time" sounds unnatural, and the connection between the storm and changing the country's fate needs clearer explanation.

**Exemplar:** *All hope of peace was shattered, but this sudden interruption would eventually bring a reward that could change the entire country's fate.*

■ Your piece shows strong creative imagination and attempts to use sophisticated vocabulary, which demonstrates good writing ambition. However, your ideas need clearer connections between sentences and paragraphs to help readers follow your story more easily. Additionally, you should focus on making your descriptions clearer so readers can picture exactly what's happening. Also, work on connecting your ideas more smoothly by using linking words like "meanwhile," "however," and "consequently." Furthermore, practise checking that your word choices sound natural in English - sometimes simpler, clearer words work better than complex ones that don't fit properly. Your story structure shows promise, but you need to explain the connections between events more clearly, especially why the storm would change the whole country. Moreover, focus on writing shorter, clearer sentences before building up to longer, more complex ones.
