## Section 1:

#1 "I loved reading adventure books – more than anything like eating cakes, playing board games or maybe even more than my dog. Strengths: You've created a strong opening that establishes your character's love for adventure books. Your description of the setting with the "sun painted tree barks golden" uses vivid imagery.

Weakness: Abrupt transition  $\rightarrow$  The transition from reading under a tree to suddenly being teleported happens too quickly without enough build-up or explanation. The reader doesn't get to experience the magical moment fully because it happens in just one sentence. For instance, "All of a sudden, a shiver went down my spine hypnotizing me and my eyes blurred" rushes through what could be an exciting moment of discovery.

Exemplar: As I turned the page of my book, a strange tingling sensation crept up my arms. The words on the page began to shimmer and dance. A shiver ran down my spine as my vision blurred, and suddenly I felt myself being pulled into a swirling vortex of colour, landing upside down with my head in what felt like a pit of soft, fluffy marshmallows.

#2 "As I approached the tree, a rope dangled from the side. Pulling tight, I climbed it and at the end of it I discovered sweet, juicy, marble sized berries on prickly vines. I quickly picked a few and packed them in my emergency snack box just in case I am hungry."

Strengths: You've included sensory details about the berries ("sweet, juicy, marble sized"). The "emergency snack box" is a clever detail that shows your character comes prepared.

Weakness: Limited character reaction → You don't show much emotion or curiosity when discovering magical elements like the rope or berries. How did you feel seeing these unusual things? Were you surprised, excited, or nervous about trying magical berries? The sentence "I quickly picked a few" doesn't capture what could be a moment of wonder or hesitation.

Exemplar: My heart raced with excitement as I spotted the rope hanging from the magnificent tree. After tugging it to make sure it was secure, I began to climb. My eyes widened with amazement when I discovered clusters of rainbow-coloured, marble-sized berries growing on prickly vines. "Could these be magical?" I wondered, carefully selecting the juiciest ones and tucking them into my emergency snack box.

#3 "There was a flying cake that grants us wishes. I wished for fly, but I sneezed while saying it, and it came out as fry. Then the cake exploded into boiling pancakes. At least Moonface had a piece of cake and then I wished to fly, and we were all flying in the sky."

Strengths: You've included a creative complication with the sneeze changing "fly" to "fry," which shows good imagination. The idea of a wish-granting cake is also very original.

Weakness: Underdeveloped sequence → This exciting part of the story feels rushed with too many events happening in quick succession without enough details. The cake exploding into "boiling pancakes" and then suddenly everyone flying happens too quickly without describing how the characters reacted or what flying felt like. The phrase "At least Moonface had a piece of cake" doesn't clearly connect to the story.

Exemplar: Before me floated an enormous birthday cake, its candles flickering with rainbow flames. "This cake grants wishes," Silky explained with a wink. Taking a deep breath, I prepared to wish for the ability to fly, but just as I spoke, a tickle in my nose caused me to sneeze. "I wish to f-f-ACHOO!-fry!" I stammered. With a thunderous BOOM, the cake exploded, transforming into dozens of sizzling, boiling pancakes that rained down around us. "Oh no!" I cried, as Moonface managed to catch a remaining piece of the magical cake. "Quick, make another wish!" he urged, offering me a bite. This time, I carefully enunciated, "I wish for us to FLY," and instantly we were lifted into the air, soaring through cotton candy clouds with delighted squeals.

■ Your magical story shows wonderful imagination and creativity! The setting you've created with the magical tree, unique characters like Dame Washlot, Silky and Moonface, and fantastic elements like flying cakes and birthday land is truly special. To make your writing even more engaging, try slowing down at important moments to include more sensory details – what did things smell, sound or feel like? Additionally, you could show more of your character's thoughts and feelings throughout the adventure. When you met the magical characters, were you surprised, scared, or excited? Also, try connecting your paragraphs with smoother transitions to help your reader follow the journey more easily. For instance, you could explain how you moved from one part of the tree to another. Your story has so many creative ideas – giving each one more space to develop would make the magical world feel even more real to your readers.
