Exemplar: A harsh, buzzing sound sliced through the chirps of the blue hummingbirds.

Strengths: You effectively establish the surreal nature of the story with the image of the animated alarm clock.

Weakness: Inconsistent pronoun capitalisation → The pronoun "i" is not capitalised throughout your writing. Also, you're missing commas to separate clauses properly.

Exemplar: I slapped the alarm clock with full force. 7:50. As I turned to open the curtains, my alarm clock popped its legs out and started pacing around my feet.

#3 I was preparing of the worst for school.

Strengths: You convey the character's anxiety about the strange situation effectively.

Weakness: Length and development \rightarrow Your piece is extremely brief overall, and this sentence particularly lacks development. The preposition "of" is incorrect.

Exemplar: I was preparing for the worst day at school, imagining all the chaos that might unfold if everything I touched came to life.

■ Your piece introduces a fascinating concept with objects coming to life when touched, but needs significant expansion to reach its full potential. The brevity prevents readers from fully engaging with your creative world. Try adding more sensory details about how the character feels seeing these strange events. What emotions are they experiencing—fear, wonder, confusion? Also, consider developing a proper beginning, middle and end structure to your story. You could expand on the consequences of this strange power at school, perhaps creating a specific incident that forms the climax of your story. Adding dialogue would also make your writing more engaging—perhaps the character could talk to

someone about what's happening or even try speaking to the animated objects! Focus on building your story to meet the required word count while maintaining your creative concept.
