Repetitive sentence starts → You begin multiple sentences with "then" which makes your writing sound choppy. There's also overuse of exclamation marks which reduces their impact.

Underdeveloped ending \rightarrow The resolution happens too quickly without enough detail about how holding the sock sends Samuel back to Earth. The ending feels rushed and doesn't give readers a satisfying conclusion.

This will create a smoother reading experience and make your writing more engaging.
