## #1 Strengths:

- Your introduction cleverly poses a question to engage readers.
- You establish your identity and purpose clearly.

Weakness: Lack of specific environmental examples → Your opening paragraphs define Earth as "very dirty and not hygienic" without providing concrete examples. You mention "littering, not showing respect, and starting fights" but these remain abstract concepts. Including specific environmental issues would strengthen your argument.

Exemplar: *Earth is the land you are standing on; it is currently suffering from serious environmental problems like plastic pollution in our oceans, deforestation of our precious rainforests, and air pollution from factories and vehicles.*

## #2 Strengths:

- Your paragraph about littering connects well to your main argument.
- You make a logical connection between trees, oxygen and our survival.

Weakness: Underdeveloped cause-effect relationships → Your paragraph about littering starts strongly but jumps quickly between ideas. The connection between "throwing belongings in the lake" and "if we don't have oxygen, then we can't breathe" needs clearer explanation. The relationship between littering and tree loss isn't fully developed.

Exemplar: *Garbage bins are provided in our communities for a reason. When we throw rubbish into lakes instead, this pollution kills water plants and animals. Similarly, when we cut down trees without replanting them, we reduce the amount of oxygen produced, which all humans need to survive.*

## #3 Strengths:

- Your conclusion effectively restates your main points.
- You use a powerful reminder about our connection to Earth.

Weakness: Repetitive phrasing without development → Your conclusion repeats the phrase "You must take care of the environment" without providing specific actions readers can take. Each paragraph ends with this statement, but doesn't build on what caring for the environment actually involves.

Exemplar: *Therefore, you must take care of the environment by making simple changes in your daily life: use rubbish bins properly, plant native trees in your garden or school, and speak respectfully to others about working together to solve environmental problems.*

■ Your piece shows passion for environmental protection, which comes through strongly in your writing. However, you could improve the depth of your argument by including specific examples of environmental damage and concrete solutions. Also, try to create stronger connections between your ideas instead of jumping between concepts. When you mention littering in lakes, explain exactly why this harms the environment and what specific impacts it has. Additionally, consider adding a paragraph about positive actions people are already taking to protect the environment, which would balance your critique with hope. Your repeated call to action ("You must take care of the environment") would be more powerful if you varied it slightly each time and paired it with specific suggestions for how readers can make a difference in their daily lives.
