

Section 1:

#1 "These innocent animals are carried out of their families for food, clothing or circus shows and entertainment. It's known that over 1 million animals are killed each year! For what? Just for our taste or is it our tongue that likes butter chicken or is it the excuse of that meat is healthy even when we have fresh vegetables, approved to no diseases or hurt."

Strengths:

- You use emotive language effectively to create an emotional connection with your audience
- Your rhetorical questions engage the reader and make them reflect on their own choices

Weakness: Unclear sentence structure → The sentence "...even when we have fresh vegetables, approved to no diseases or hurt" is confusing and doesn't clearly communicate your point. The phrasing "approved to no diseases" doesn't make sense grammatically. You need to restructure this to make your comparison between meat and vegetables clearer.

Exemplar: *"...even when we have fresh vegetables that are healthy and cause no harm to animals."*

#2 "Yet this may seem like a scene from a horror movie, however this is the harsh reality for these animals."

Strengths:

- You effectively create a powerful contrast between fiction and reality
- You use imagery that helps readers visualise the severity of animal testing

Weakness: Double conjunction → You've used both "yet" and "however" in the same sentence, which creates a redundancy. These words serve the same purpose of showing contrast, so using both weakens your sentence structure.

Exemplar: *"This may seem like a scene from a horror movie, but this is the harsh reality for these animals."*

#3 "Do you know that covid 19 was made by 2 animals that had a disease and then those diseases got together to make this pandemic. While a recent pole study tells us that over 500,000 people died because of this pandemonium."

Strengths:

- You attempt to connect animal issues to human health concerns, which is relevant
- You try to use real-world examples to support your argument

Weakness: Factual imprecision and sentence fragments → Your explanation of COVID-19's origins is oversimplified and inaccurate. Additionally, the second sentence begins with "While" but doesn't have a main clause to complete the thought. "Pole" is also used instead of "poll".

Exemplar: *"Research suggests that COVID-19 likely originated from animals before spreading to humans. A recent poll showed that over 500,000 people died because of this pandemic, highlighting how animal diseases can affect human health."*

■ Your persuasive speech shows passion for animal welfare, which comes through strongly in your writing. To improve the substance of your work, focus on organising your arguments more clearly. Your introduction grabs attention, but try to state your main points more precisely. Your second paragraph about animal cruelty would be stronger if you separated your examples rather than combining them all together. In your third paragraph about diseases, try to provide more specific and accurate information. Your conclusion could be more powerful if you included specific actions your audience can take. Also, work on your transitions between paragraphs to help your ideas flow better. Try reading your speech aloud to catch confusing sentences that might lose your audience's attention.
