Section 1:

Development of ideas \rightarrow The paragraph lacks depth in explaining the appeal of trainspotting to enthusiasts. You've stated what it is but haven't explored why people might enjoy it beyond saying it's unclear. "Trainspotting enthusiasts often collect detailed information about different train models, their historical significance, and unique features—similar to how others might collect stamps or trading cards."

#3 "The three activities I mentioned above are just some of the weird, unique and peculiar hobbies. Some other examples include extreme ironing, competitive dog grooming, dirt polishing and beetle fighting. I could go on and on, but we'll stop there for now because I don't want to make this article too boring."

Strengths: You've expanded the scope by mentioning additional unusual hobbies, which reinforces your main theme. The casual tone maintains reader engagement.

For example, you could mention the history of cheese rolling or why trainspotting enthusiasts find their hobby rewarding. Also, your paragraphs would benefit from stronger transitions between them to guide readers smoothly from one hobby to the next. Try adding connecting phrases that link ideas together more clearly. The conclusion needs more purpose—instead of suggesting your writing might become boring, consider ending with a thought-provoking statement about what these unusual hobbies reveal about human nature or creativity. Adding these elements would give your piece more substance and make it more satisfying for readers. Additionally, varying your sentence structure would make your writing flow better and sound more sophisticated.
