Weakness: Fragmented sentence structure → Your sentences are too choppy and incomplete. Phrases like "Recess. Normal. Lunch. Normal" are sentence fragments that make your writing feel disconnected and hard to follow smoothly.

Exemplar: *I woke up and went to school, where everything proceeded as usual. Recess was normal, lunch was normal, but after school, something shocking happened.*

Strengths: Your writing shows creativity in exploring the consequences of a world without physics. You're testing different scenarios to understand what this change means.

Weakness: Lack of emotional depth → Your writing focuses only on the physical actions without exploring how you feel about these strange events. The reader cannot connect with your character's experience because there's no emotional response to these remarkable discoveries.

Exemplar: *I ran home and deliberately crashed my head into the corner of the table, amazed when it caused no pain or injury. My heart raced with excitement as I realised the impossible had become possible.*

#3 - "All devices could not work at all. All shops shut down and nobody could leave homes. You had to be tied up to your bed when sleeping as there were no gravity."

Strengths: Your writing demonstrates logical thinking about the widespread consequences of physics disappearing. You consider how this change would affect everyday life and society.

Weakness: Inconsistent narrative voice → Your writing suddenly switches from first person ("I") to second person ("You") without explanation. This change confuses readers about whose story they're following and makes the narrative feel unstable.

Exemplar: *All devices stopped working, shops closed down, and people couldn't leave their homes. I had to tie myself to my bed when sleeping because there was no gravity.*

■ Your piece presents an imaginative concept about a world where physics stops working, which shows creative thinking and the ability to consider cause and effect. However, your writing would benefit from more detailed descriptions and smoother sentence flow. The story jumps quickly from one event to another without giving readers time to understand or feel invested in what's happening. Additionally, you could strengthen your writing by including more sensory details and emotions to help readers experience the story alongside your character. Consider expanding on how these changes affect not just physical actions but also feelings and thoughts. Also, maintaining the same narrative voice throughout would help readers follow your story more easily. Your conclusion effectively brings the story full circle, but the middle sections could use more development to create a more engaging reading experience.
