#1 Strengths: Your introduction poses an engaging question about having a sixth sense, which immediately captures the reader's interest. You also clearly state your chosen sixth sense (teleportation).

Underdeveloped premise → Your opening lacks depth and could benefit from a more substantial explanation of what constitutes a "sixth sense" versus a superpower. The phrase "It could be anything!" suggests you haven't fully developed the concept before introducing teleportation.

Limited explanation → You mention several uses for teleportation but don't explore any of them in detail. For example, when you write "Teleportation can also be used in things like construction," you don't explain how it would work in construction or provide specific examples.

Imagine being able to teleport building materials instantly to remote locations, eliminating the need for costly transportation and reducing construction time from months to days. During emergency situations, I could teleport medical supplies or rescue people trapped in dangerous areas without risking more lives.

#3 Strengths: You acknowledge potential downsides of teleportation, which shows balanced thinking. Your bank robbery example effectively illustrates a specific negative consequence.

Brevity → Your entire piece is very short, particularly evident in this conclusion which consists of just two sentences. The statement "Teleportation is extremely helpful" repeats earlier points without adding new insights or providing a thoughtful reflection on the overall implications.

While teleportation would revolutionise how we live, work and travel, it would require careful regulation. I believe the benefits—eliminating pollution from vehicles, reducing geographical barriers between communities, and saving countless hours spent commuting—would ultimately outweigh the risks if we established proper safeguards to prevent misuse.

■ Your piece presents an interesting concept but needs significant expansion to reach its full potential. The current length limits your ability to explore your ideas thoroughly. You've identified both positives and negatives of teleportation, which shows good critical thinking, but each point needs more

development with specific examples and details. Try expanding each paragraph by adding vivid descriptions of how teleportation would work and what it would feel like. Also, consider organising your writing more clearly with separate paragraphs for introduction, benefits, limitations, and conclusion. Additionally, you could strengthen your piece by addressing questions like: How would teleportation change society? Would everyone have this ability or just you? How would it feel to teleport? Your writing shows promise—with more detail and organisation, you could create a truly engaging piece about this fascinating ability.
