Section 1:

Strengths: Your opening grabs the reader's attention immediately with exciting action. You've created a clear sense of danger and urgency that makes us want to keep reading.

Weakness: Unclear scene transition → The connection between your dream sequence and the real world becomes confusing. When you write "I suddenly unexpectedly woke up," readers lose track of what's happening because there's no clear signal that we were in a dream from the start.

Exemplar: I found myself racing through dark woods in what felt like the most vivid dream of my life, clutching a sacred copper locket to my chest.

#2 - Middle section: "I wasn't giving up yet. I searched the entire house from the underground basement to the roof. I couldn't find anything about a locket until I opened a mini closet disguised as a filing cabinet."

Strengths: Your determination to prove the doctor wrong shows good character development. The discovery of the hidden note creates genuine mystery and intrigue.

Weakness: Rushed pacing → Your search happens too quickly without showing the effort involved. Phrases like "I searched the entire house" tell us what happened but don't let us experience the frustration and hope you felt during this important part of your story.

Exemplar: For three hours, I searched every corner of the house, checking behind old furniture and inside forgotten boxes, my hope fading with each empty drawer I opened.

#3 - Ending section: "The locket opened revealing an obnoxious eye. Then, it exploded releasing black gas which slowly started morphing together. Two eyes as black as death formed."

Strengths: Your ending has a surprising twist that changes everything we thought we knew about the locket. The transformation scene creates a spooky atmosphere that fits well with your adventure story.

Weakness: Incomplete resolution \rightarrow Your story ends right when the most interesting part begins. The phrase "I had unleashed an unstoppable reign of terror" promises more story, but we don't learn what happens next or how your character deals with this problem.

Exemplar: As the dark creature towered over the frightened dinosaurs, I realised I needed to find a way to reverse what I had done before this evil spread beyond the dimension.

■ Your piece shows real creativity in mixing dreams, mystery, and adventure into one exciting story. The idea of a locket that opens portals to different worlds is imaginative and engaging. However, your story would benefit from slowing down in key moments to help readers understand what's happening. Currently, events happen so quickly that we don't get time to feel the emotions your character experiences. Additionally, your story needs stronger connections between different partsthe jump from dream to reality, then to the attic search, feels choppy. To improve your writing, try spending more time on each major event. For example, when your character searches the house, show us the mess they make and their growing frustration. Also, consider giving your character more of a personality by showing their thoughts and feelings about what's happening. Finally, your ending needs to resolve the main problem or at least show us how your character plans to fix the situation they've created.
