Challenging Mistakes: Why Dialogue Fails

- Overuse of 'said', bland speech tags
- Excessive exposition between speech
- Dialogue not matching **character voice**
- **Dialogue dump** (too much at once)

Exemplar 1: Poor Attempt (Sophisticated Vocabulary)

"I propose we participate in the forthcoming literary endurance challenge—the twenty-four-hour charity read-a-thon," articulated Emily, maintaining a neutral expression despite the significance of her suggestion.

"Your proposition, while undoubtedly well-intentioned, fails to acknowledge the detrimental impact such an undertaking would have on our already substantial academic obligations," responded Amir, proceeding to elaborate extensively. "The committee organising this charitable endeavour has established parameters that are, in my considered opinion, wholly unreasonable for students with our level of commitments."

Sophisticated Yet Flawed

- Excessive formality
- Unnatural exposition
- Identical voice patterns
- Lacks emotional texture
- No conversational rhythm
- Absence of physicality



Critical Analysis: Despite sophisticated vocabulary and complex sentence structures, this dialogue remains ineffective. The characters sound identical, with neither distinctive voices nor authentic speech patterns. The artificiality of the exchange prevents reader engagement and emotional investment.

Diagnose the Problems

- **Flat tone** - characters sound identical, lacking distinctive voices
- **No personality or tension** - dialogue fails to reveal character or drive plot
- **No actions or reactions** - dialogue exists in a physical vacuum

Meme: Flat Dialogue Disaster

When your characters sound like they're reading from a phone book...

"Hello." "Hi." "How are you?" "Fine."

EXAMINERS: [instantly falls asleep]

Strategy:

For each piece of dialogue ask: Does it reveal character? Create tension? Advance the plot? If not, revise or remove it.

Identify and Fix Dialogue Flaws

Problem: Generic speech

→ Add unique vocabulary and speech patterns

Problem: Just talking heads

→ Insert action beats to show body language

Problem: On-the-nose dialogue

→ Create subtext: characters hint, not state

Apply these fixes to transform weak dialogue into compelling exchanges

Exemplar 2: Improved Attempt

"Perhaps if you reconsidered the opportunity," **Emily ventured, leaning forward with a calculated glimmer in her eyes.** "The literature selection alone merits participation."

Amir's fingers drummed an agitated rhythm on the table's edge. "Merit is subjective. One person's enlightenment is another's tedium," he countered, his gaze drifting to the window.

"How convenient that your principles align perfectly with avoiding commitment," she remarked, **her tone light yet barbed.** "Literary avoidance masquerading as philosophical stance?"

A shadow of hesitation crossed his face. "Previous experiences have proved... **less than fulfilling.** The pretense of intellectual discourse often eclipses genuine literary appreciation."



Dialogue Duel: The Hemingway Method

Hemingway believed dialogue should do multiple things simultaneously: advance plot, reveal character, and create tension—all while appearing completely natural. His "iceberg theory" suggested good dialogue shows only 10% of what's happening beneath the surface.
