#1: Opening Hook (First Paragraph)

Strengths:

- You've created a clear personal connection by stating that nachos are your favourite comfort food, which helps readers understand your perspective right from the start.
- Your writing sets up an interesting promise by mentioning that you'll explain why nachos deserve this special status.

Unclear Sentence Structure → Your opening sentence reads "a few dishes rival in texture, taste, and enjoyment that nachos bring to the table," but this creates confusion about what you're actually trying to say. Are you saying that few dishes can compete with nachos, or that some dishes do rival them? The phrase "rival in texture, taste, and enjoyment that nachos bring" doesn't flow smoothly because it's missing connecting words that would help readers understand the comparison you're making.

Exemplar: When it comes to comfort food for me, few dishes can rival the texture, taste, and enjoyment that nachos bring to the table.

#2: Sensory Description (Third Paragraph)

Strengths:

- You've included specific sensory details like "crispy chips," "creamy avocado," and "refreshing lettuce," which help readers imagine the food.
- Your attempt to describe the layers shows you're thinking about how different parts of the dish work together.

Incomplete Development → Whilst you mention a "symphony of flavours" and describe some textures, you haven't actually told us what these flavours taste like or why they work well together. For instance, you say each ingredient plays its own role, but you don't explain what that role is. What does the avocado add beyond being creamy? How does the lettuce's refreshing quality balance the other

ingredients? Your paragraph lists ingredients but doesn't give readers enough information to truly understand why these combinations create something special.

Exemplar: The crispy chips provide a satisfying crunch that contrasts beautifully with the smooth, buttery richness of the avocado, whilst the fresh lettuce adds a cool, crisp bite that cuts through the heavier flavours and prevents each mouthful from feeling too rich.

#3: Social Aspect (Fifth Paragraph)

Strengths:

- You've introduced an interesting idea that nachos can bring people together and create social connections.
- The specific example of a meal starting with small talk and ending with planning future hangouts helps readers picture the situation.

Vague Connection \rightarrow You describe a social situation where people connect over nachos, but you haven't explained *why* nachos specifically create this effect. Would the same thing happen with any shared food? What is it about sharing nachos that makes conversations flow or helps people bond? The paragraph tells us that sharing nachos brings joy, but it doesn't show us the connection between the food itself and the social experience. Without this explanation, your point feels incomplete and doesn't strengthen your argument that nachos are the ultimate food.

Exemplar: Sharing a bowl of nachos encourages interaction in a way that individual meals cannot—everyone reaches into the centre, hands accidentally brush, people laugh about who got the chip with the most toppings, and these small, playful moments naturally break down barriers and spark genuine conversation.

■ Your piece shows enthusiasm for your topic, which is wonderful, but it needs more depth to truly convince readers that nachos deserve the title of "ultimate food." Right now, your writing tells readers that nachos are great, but it doesn't always show them why through detailed explanations and examples. To strengthen your content, focus on developing each point fully before moving to the next one. For instance, when you mention that nachos can be customised, you could give specific examples of different nacho variations you've tried or explain how changing one ingredient completely transforms the dish. Additionally, your paragraph about bringing people together would benefit from

exploring the specific qualities of nachos that create social bonding—perhaps the communal nature of eating from one plate, or the fun of building your perfect bite. Also, think about addressing potential questions readers might have: what makes nachos better than other customisable foods like pizza or tacos? Your conclusion mentions that nachos are easy to make at home, but this idea appears suddenly without being developed in the body paragraphs. Try to ensure each claim you make in your introduction and conclusion is properly explored in the middle sections. Finally, work on your sentence construction to ensure each sentence clearly communicates one complete thought before moving to the next idea.
