#1 "Every action leaves a scar. None, as deep, as the tearing wound fo a fatal car crash. Every incident gone by, leaves a gap. A empty seat on the car. A blank canvas on a families art wall."

Strengths:

- Your opening creates a powerful emotional tone through the use of metaphor, particularly with "scar" and "tearing wound"
- Your use of concrete imagery (empty seat, blank canvas) effectively conveys the human cost of accidents

Weakness: Fragmented sentence structure → Your writing relies heavily on incomplete sentences and fragments, which disrupts the flow of ideas. While fragments can create emphasis, overusing them weakens your persuasive impact.

#2 "Automation. A Ignored factor, yet a saviour. no more fatigue is needed. You can flick a switch, let the doors open and slump down. Tap. Tap. Tap."

Strengths:

- Your introduction of automation as a solution provides a clear turning point in your argument
- The repetition of "Tap. Tap. Tap." creates an effective sensory moment

Weakness: Underdeveloped reasoning → Your explanation of how automation prevents accidents lacks depth and clarity. You mention that users can "flick a switch" and "slump down," but you don't explain why this reduces accidents or how the technology actually works to improve safety. Simply stating that "no more fatigue is needed" doesn't convince your reader—you need to show the connection between automation and accident prevention through specific examples or evidence.

Exemplar: Automation addresses driver fatigue by allowing the vehicle to control itself during long journeys, removing the human error that causes thousands of deaths each year. When a driver activates the system, sensors and cameras monitor the road continuously, something a tired human cannot do.

#3 "We foolishly hidde in shadows as we call our mistakes and failures accidents. The rising and dominating popularity of alchoholic items increases as manufacturers increase production."

Strengths:

- Your philosophical observation about calling mistakes "accidents" demonstrates critical thinking
- Your attempt to link alcohol popularity with increased accidents shows cause-and-effect reasoning

Weakness: Unclear connection between ideas → Your transition from the metaphor about hiding in shadows to the discussion of alcohol feels abrupt and confusing. The relationship between "calling mistakes accidents" and the popularity of alcohol isn't explained, leaving your reader uncertain about your main point. Additionally, your second paragraph repeats similar ideas about alcohol without adding new information, which makes your argument feel circular rather than progressive.

Exemplar: We avoid responsibility by labelling our reckless choices as "accidents." When drivers consume alcohol before getting behind the wheel, they make a deliberate choice that puts lives at risk—this is not an accident but a preventable mistake.

■ Your piece tackles an important topic with genuine passion, and your imagery creates memorable moments throughout. However, your argument would strengthen considerably if you organised your ideas more clearly and avoided repeating the same points about alcohol and speed across multiple paragraphs. Additionally, your writing would benefit from developing each point fully before moving to the next—for instance, when you introduce automation, explain one benefit completely with evidence before listing another. Also, your opening paragraphs would flow better if you combined some of the short, choppy sentences into longer, more connected thoughts. Finally, proofread carefully for spelling errors (like "fo" instead of "for" and "hidde" instead of "hide"), as these mistakes distract from your otherwise powerful message.
